H. SUPERINTENDENT’S REPORT

Superintendent’s Consent Items

- Approve hiring up to 5 adults for summer maintenance help at the custodian substitute pay rate for up to 32 hours per week.
- Approve hiring up to 2 students for summer maintenance help at a rate of \$9.30 per hour up to 20 hours per week.
- Approve hiring up to 2 students for summer maintenance help at a rate of \$9.30 per hour. Total hours will not exceed 40 hours per week per student.
- Approve hiring one student for summer technology help at a rate of \$9.35 per hour. Total hours will not exceed 240 hours.
- Approve hiring 1 adult for summer technology help at the custodian substitute pay rate for up to 120 hours.
- Approve the attached list of substitute teachers provided by the Mercer County Educational Service Center.
- Approve Art Bader as a tutor effective the beginning of the 2021-22 school year. The rate of pay will be \$16 per hour with no more than five hours per week.

- Approve payment of a \$900 stipend to Classified and Administrative staff members who work four or more hours per day; and a \$450 stipend to those who work less than four hours per day, effective the 2021-22 school year. Classified staff members who are also on a certified contract are not part of this group.

PAY WILL BE PRORATED ACCORDINGLY FOR SHORTENED EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES/SEASONS.
